Collaborative co-design: Partners are invited to participate in the co-design of projects, contributing ideas and expertise to shape high-impact research.



Input through committees: Partners can join project advisory comittees (PACs) or regainol advisory committees (RACs), helping guide the development and prioritisation of research initiatives or hub activity.



Feedback and prioritisation: We regularly consult with partners through surveys, briefings, and meetings, ensuring their input is reflected in the project activities.
